



## Initial Applicants

Those who have not applied for a Foundation scholarship grant before

- A. In narrative form, answer the following questions with a minimum of 100 words per question.
  1. Describe service and volunteer activities in which you have been involved (high school, college, and community). Include honors, awards, scholarships, and positions of leadership.
  2. Describe how you have been *active* and involved in worship and the life of the church either here at First Lutheran Church and/or at the location of your college as it applies to you.
  3. Describe your career plans and how you feel your Christian faith will shape the way you live and serve in your anticipated occupation.
- B. Provide a name, title, and address of one person who can give us an evaluation of your academic achievements and potential.
- C. Have a current official high school (if you will graduate from high school in the spring) or official college transcript (if you are a continuing college student) sent to the church. Transcripts are part of your application and must be received at the church by the application deadline.

## Renewal Applicants

Those who have applied for a Foundation scholarship grant in past years

- A. Provide a name, title, and address of one person who can give us an evaluation of your academic achievements and potential.
- B. Have a current official college transcript sent to the church. Transcripts are part of your application and must be received at the church by the deadline.
- C. Describe how you have grown in faith and served others during the past year.

**Applications must be received at the church office by 5 p.m., April 1, prior to the fall term of school for which you seek funding. Incomplete or late applications will not receive consideration.**
